Guest Policies

Grand Canyon University is a dry campus and as such possession or use of alcohol or alcohol related paraphernalia is prohibited on campus. Individuals should also not be under the influence of alcohol while on any part of the GCU campus.

Please observe all designated smoking areas and remember that the use of tobacco products is not allowed in any building or within 100 ft of any building entrance.

Illegal drugs or drug paraphernalia are prohibited from campus. Possession of someone else's prescription drugs, or improper use of prescription drugs, is also prohibited.

Firearms, ammunition and weapons of any kind are prohibited on campus. This includes, but is not limited to, firearms, BB guns, air soft guns, water balloon launchers, paint ball guns, blowguns, knives and fireworks.

Pets are not allowed on campus.

As a Christian University, Grand Canyon University strives to remain above reproach in all encounters with members of the opposite gender. For this reason, members of the opposite sex are allowed to visit during specified hours in the living room in each suite, however they are not allowed in bedrooms. When members of the opposite sex are present the front door must be propped open. Visitation hours are as follows:

Sunday – Saturday 12:00pm to 10:00pm

Please keep in mind that Canyon Hall is a residential community for GCU student. During your stay, we ask that you be respectful of those that call Canyon "home" just as we ask them to be respectful of you as our special guest.

For the safety and security of our campus community the propping of any exit doors is prohibited.
